Dear Nassau Community College Applicant:

We are pleased to learn of your interest in Nassau Community College and delighted to offer you the opportunity to apply for one of the most prestigious scholarships at our institution!

Any graduating high school student who enrolls as a full-time day student at NCC with a program emphasis in one of the following areas, may apply for a **Joseph F. Carlino, Jr. Memorial Scholarship**:

MATHEMATICS - Admissions/Registrar's Code #47; or
COMPUTER SCIENCE - Admissions/Registrar's Code #53; or
COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS - Admissions/Registrar's Code #C1

Each scholarship covers Nassau County resident tuition and fees for the **fall 2009** semester. (Students who do not reside in Nassau County are responsible for the difference between resident and non-resident tuition and fees.) An additional award in the amount of \$250.00 will be given, at the completion of the spring 2010 semester, to those winning scholars who meet all the following requirements:

- * Continue to register as a full-time student with a mathematics or computer major; (Admissions/Registrar's Codes 47, 53 or C1)
- * Follow the mathematics or computer program of study printed in the College Catalog or MAT/CMP brochure;
- * Make satisfactory progress towards the degree as evidenced by the achievement of at least a 3.0 GPA in each of the preceding two semesters, and
- * Achieve at least a 3.0 math/computer average with no mathematics and no computer final grade below a C.

The deadline for submission of a scholarship application is **July 15th**. Candidates will be judged on their mathematical ability, their SAT scores, their class rank, and their interest in the fields of math and/or computers.

If you are interested in applying for a Carlino Memorial Scholarship, please go our website at www.nccft@ncc.edu for the application packet. Your application packet should include your application, an official school transcript of your grades; two completed reference forms from high school math or computer teachers; and a personal statement. (Your personal statement should explain why you plan to major in the mathematics or computer science fields, your relevant high school background and experience, your plans for continuing your education, and your career aspirations.) Please be sure to sign this personal statement.

Once you have gathered all the required documents listed on the application checklist, mail the entire packet to the Federation of Teachers, Nassau Community College, 1 Education Drive - Room F3293, Garden City, NY 11530-6793. Your application packet must be received before the **July 15th** deadline. **Please Note: Late or incomplete applications will NOT be considered.**
