Starting in January 2005, the Empire Plan has changed its fee schedule for co-payments. Some changes include:

- Medical co-payments will be \$15
- Prescription co-payments will be determined by three levels:
 - Generic - \$5
 - Preferred brand name - \$15
 - Non-preferred name drug - \$30.
